## Procedure:

1. Open PowerPoint. Click on File → Open and locate the template named **Animal** in your user folder. Click **OK**.
2. Click on the first slide and change **My Animal** to the name of your animal.
3. Click on Insert → Picture and search in the clip art gallery or clips on-line to find a picture of your animal.
4. Click in the textbox next to Name and add your name.
5. Continue to the next slide and add a textbox and picture to complete the presentation.
6. Remember that your bibliography must include all resources. This would include the graphics too.
7. Once you have completed all of the slides of your presentation add transitions to each slide. Click on Slide Show → Custom Animations.
8. Spell check your presentation.
9. View your slide show in Slide Show mode. Click Slide Show → View Show.
