

Our Favorite Idioms

Overview: In this activity you will create a PowerPoint presentation that will feature 30 idioms.

1. Complete the Idiomatic Expressions worksheet using the Internet as a resource. Use the following websites to help you.

 - c. <http://dictionary.cambridge.org/>
2. When you finish your worksheet Open the Idioms PowerPoint template located in your user folder.
3. Begin with slide one and make the necessary changes as directed. Continue to slide three and follow those directions. Once you have edited the Table of Contents using your worksheet, continue to slides 6 – 12 and create each slide as directed. **Note: Please do not work on the graphics at this point.
4. Ask another student to use their Idiomatic Expressions worksheet to complete the next slides. It will be necessary to borrow several worksheets. Make sure you don't use the same idiom twice. Continue to work until all idioms are complete including the slides
5. Now it's time to work on the graphics for each slide. Remember that the graphics should illustrate the idiomatic expression on that slide. A word of caution, following the directions "click icon to add content" seems to freeze the computer. Instead, Click Insert → Picture → Clip Art. Use several clip art and edit them to represent your idiom. It is ok to use clips online in your search.
6. Save this in your user folder. It is not necessary to print this assignment.
