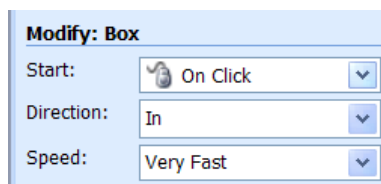


Creating An Electronic History Photo Album

1. You will be creating a photo album of the event you selected with your teacher using Microsoft PowerPoint.
2. The focus of this lesson: search and find pictures using a major search engine (google, yahoo, or dogpile), develop a multimedia slideshow using PowerPoint, using transitions to make the presentation an effective visual project.
3. Using a search engine begin to gather pictures into a file. Save them into your user folder → computer folder and create a new folder named pictures.
4. Once you have 10 to 15 pictures open PowerPoint and begin to create your album. You may use 2 to 3 pictures per slide. Use transitions to make this an effective presentation.
5. Making transitions in PowerPoint is easy. Click on Slideshow → Custom animation.
6. Click on the add effect button and selection an animation sequence. Once you have added the transition



you can modify it in the modify box. Review the effect

using the play button or change the order of transitions by dragging the effect up or down in the list.
